

DAVID HACK RUN – SATURDAY 18TH MAY 2018

- 9.00am Assemble at the Brisbane Planetarium Car Park
- 9.30 Departure by heading East on Sir Samuel Griffith Drive in the direction of the Western Freeway, travelling on that road until veering left into the Moggill Road exit.(it's the 1st exit) where you turn right onto Moggill Road
- 9.50 Travel Moggill Road through Kenmore Shopping Centre , continuing on Moggill Road until signs direct to Mt Crosby Road, Turn right onto Mt Crosby Road
- Travel past the Mt Crosby Water Treatment Plant, through the Village of Mt Crosby, crossing the Brisbane River at College's Crossing and heading towards Ipswich
- 10.15 Turn right onto the Ipswich By Pass, heading west towards Marburg,
- 10.35 Turn left off the Warrego Highway just after the Plainlands Hotel at Marburg and proceed into the Main Street of Marburg. **COFFEE** and a couple of Antique Shops
- 11.00 Turning Left out of the main street of Marburg, heading for Rosewood, turning right at the roundabout in Rosewood and heading for Laidley/Forest Hill heading towards Gatton
- Drive west through Gatton, as if you were travelling to Grantham
- 11.50 Turn right into the Locker Valley Gallery and Cultural Centre (Look for the signs to Lake Apex, the Cultural Centre over looks it)
- LUNCH** There is quite good restaurant/café on site
- You've travelled 105 kilometres
- Within the building there is a Public Gallery with local art work and the building also houses the Queensland Transport Museum for which there is a \$6.00 admission. Lots of interesting Queensland vehicles & memorabilia
- You can also stroll around the Lake if you are so minded.
- 1.00pm Depart the Cultural Centre and turn left into Warwick – Clifton Road, noting the large cutting that you drive through about 20 kilometres after the turnoff.
- 1.15 Turn left off the road at the designated rest area which is the site of the Thiess Memorial. Pioneering Engineering Firm who made the cutting referred to earlier, went on to become big players in the Bowen Basin Coal Mines and the 1st importer of Toyota Motor vehicles into Australia. There's a long drop toilet here if you feel the need
- Continuing on past the Darling Downs Zoo travelling west you will arrive at the New England Highway where you turn left and head in the direction of Warwick
- 1.55 Arrive at Glengallen Homestead, a Heritage homestead restored by a local committee. Admission to the Homestead is \$10.00, but there is no need to go in if you don't fancy old buildings. There is a good **COFFEE** shop and cafeteria should that satisfy your desires.

- 2.25 Leaving Glengallen, we then head north on the New England Highway turning left off the highway at the Clifton turn off travelling north through Clifton, Nobby, Greenmount, Cambooya and Wyreema,
- 3.00 Turn Left at Wyreema towards Umbiram and after 3 kilometres turn right. The Umbiram road is unsealed from that point **on so we take the right turn at that point travel on a sealed road to the Gore Highway (Toowoomba Millmerran Road.)**
- 3.10 You will come to a T junction which is the Toowoomba – Millmerran road where we will turn left and head west.
- 3.25 11 kilometres after turning onto the Toowoomba- Millmerran Road we've got to do a U Turn to get onto the Western end of the new Toowoomba By Pass Road. Signage will indicate that you re headed towards Dalby
- Travelling along the by pass road, we'll skirt the new Wellcamp Airport constructed by the Wagner Brothers
- 3.50 Take the second off ramp (i.e. the Dalby Exit), turning right onto the Warrego Highway and travelling east towards Toowoomba
- 4.00 Arrival at the **Cotswold Motor Inn**, 399 Boundary Street , on your left as you approach it
