Our special guest was a Morgan replica owned by Kevin Brady a friend of MOQ member Tony McDonald, both from Redcliffe. The Morgan replica is a 'MYNX', the yellow car in the photos. Kevin, who restores classic sports cars as a hobby, gave the full story behind the impressive vehicle. We were so impressed that a quick SGM on the run later in the day empowered our Secretary Clive to invite Kevin to join the MOQ! (Details of the MYNX are given in the footnote below.)

After a brief review of the seven cars present eleven hungry people were entertained to a delicious morning tea. Some of us then went on a tour of Lance's shed while other's just enjoyed the tea, coffee and amazing variety of home baked cakes and biscuits and each others' company. Lance's collection of cars included his Cobra, Datsun 240, 1974 Ford XB falcon GT and a rare 1959 Fairthorpe with a Triumph Spitfire engine. 
